This is an 8 hour New York State Approved Safe Boating Class.

Children age 10 yrs. to adult can take the class.

Please bring the following to class with you: Pen, Pencil, 6ft. rope and your book.

*You may share a book however, the presenter suggests no more than two people per book. If you share a book please come to class with your own copies of the homework from the book.

Those age 10 to 17 who pass the course that day will receive a temporary certificate. The instructor will file your paperwork with the state, which will send you your permanent certificate. **Those age 18 and up who pass, will receive a temporary certificate and will need to send \$10 to the state to receive their permanent certificate. (All instructions for this will be given in class.) Some additional information you should be aware of: If you are operating a power vessel in another state or country and they require a safe boating certificate, you will need to check with the state or country to see if they accept the New York State Safe Boating Certificate. A number of states do accept the NYS boating cert; however it is the responsibility of the operator to check with the state or country they will be boating in.
